Welcome to our worship service today. Rev. Dr. Larry Siebrands is leading our worship on this last Sunday of Epiphany, Transfiguration Sunday. Rev. Debbie will be back with us next Sunday.

Our hymns today are recommended Transfiguration hymns. As we sing them, be thinking about how they connect to Transfiguration.

Don't forget the food bank! In our Gospel story, the 3 disciples wanted to erect 3 booths to commemorate what they had witnessed. We, however, could commemorate the Transfiguration by working to support the food bank; it depends on us.

Reminder: Our offering plate is located near the sanctuary doors. Please place your contributions there, since we will not be taking an offering as we have in the past. It's one way to be mindful of the Covid restrictions.

There will be no choir anthem today. Covid rules tell us that choirs ought not perform at this time. Everyone must wear a mask indoors, with some exceptions, e.g. people who have had pneumonia or other respiratory problems. All people must maintain at least a two metres physical distance from others. Indoor group singing, dancing and use of wind instruments have been linked to numerous outbreaks in multiple countries. So, today only, no dancing!

Today's readings and themes: Exodus 34:29-35: Why Moses wore a veil Psalm 99 The Lord is King; let the people tremble Luke 9:28-36 The transfiguration: glory on the mountain top Ash Wednesday is on March 2, next Wednesday. Ordinarily, we would have an Ash Wednesday service. However, due to Covid, we must defer! Perhaps engage in a makeshift service in your own home to mark the beginning of Lent. Ash Wednesday readings are these: Matthew 6:1-6, 16-21; Joel 2:1-2, 12-17; Psalm 51:1-17; 2 Corinthians 5:20b—6:10.

Next Sunday, March 6, is the first Sunday of Lent. The appointed readings are these: Deuteronomy 26:1-11 • Psalm 91:1-2, 9-16 • Romans 10:8b-13 • Luke 4:1-13. Take time to prepare for Sunday by previewing these lessons.

Our annual meeting is coming up. The annual report is available for you to take; it is located in the narthex. Help yourself.

Since there is no senior's meal in February, we plan to have on in March. Hopefully, today someone will give us the exact date of that meal plus other details, once they have been provided.
