Let Psalm 30 be words of comfort and direction for you this week. Psalm 30 is a song of thanksgiving. Gratitude for God's deliverance is the psalm's dominant theme. In nearly every line the psalmist either expresses thanks and praise for God's deliverance or describes the circumstances of that deliverance. It's the prayer of an individual, who recognizes God not as angry or wrathful but a God who seeks to deliver. A good memory verse is verse 5: "... his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may linger for the night, but joy comes with the morning."
